

Take Action for Children Affected by Migration

- If you have migrated to a city, register your child with local urban authorities. Your child is entitled access education, health care, legal and social services.
- If your child has been left in your rural home village, ensure that your child is receiving appropriate adult supervision, and write, call or visit your child regularly to let them know that you are thinking about them.
- Look for ways to include children of migrant parents in community activities.
- Talk to your child about how children of migrant parents have the same rights, and should have all the same opportunities, as other children.
- Talk to your school's administration about enrolling migrant children from the community.
- Talk to your local health care provider or nurse about ensuring the availability of vaccination programs for migrant children.
